



In your opinion, did this event create awareness of mental health issues? 35 responses




In your opinion, did this event reduce stigma related to mental illness?


Did you know about your school's counseling services before this event?


Did you know about Prop 63/ the community-based mental health resources before this event?


After this event, are you more or less likely to seek support for your mental health?


What type of mental health support do you think would be most useful to you?




