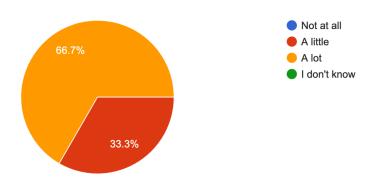

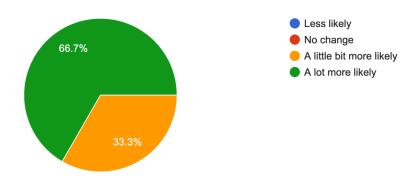

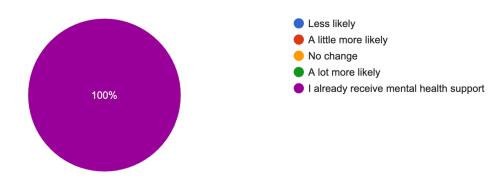

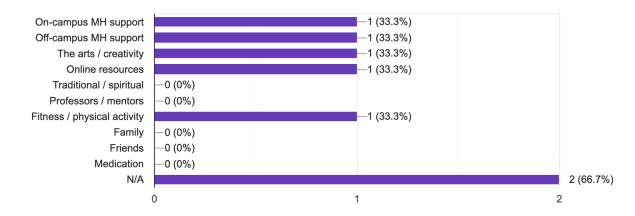

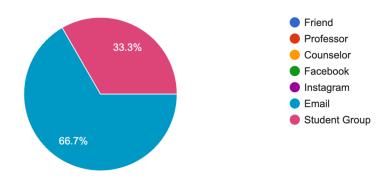

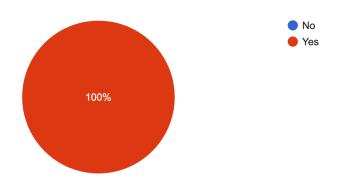

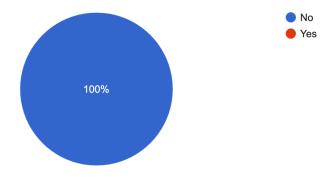


Before this event, did you know about your school's counseling services?

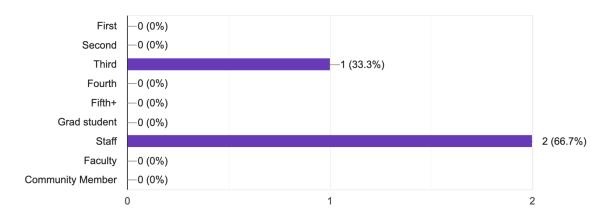
